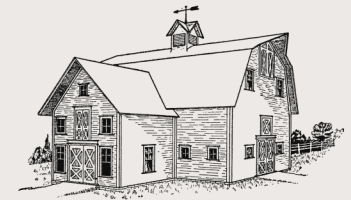

## Antique Eastern Softwoods Original Face Solid Flooring

PENNSYLVANIA BARNWOOD

Mixed softwood flooring offers a variety of Eastern Hemlock, White Pine, and Yellow Pine that is carefully selected from centuries-old Pennsylvania barn walls and floors to maintain their history in contemporary homes. The “soft” in “softwood” speaks to the nature of these wood types and their tendency to keep a record of its past uses, marking bruises and chips with unparalleled appeal. As we like to think, the more softwood is used, the more beautiful it becomes.

Our old-growth softwood includes characteristics that cannot be found in modern softwood that is rapidly grown in tree farms. Centuries ago when our old-growth softwood was standing, the trees of the dense virgin forests were fighting over resources and growing at a much slower rate, ensuring tighter grain and durability unmatched by modern softwood.

<b>Species:</b>	Eastern White & Yellow Pine and Eastern Hemlock	<b>Finish:</b>	Original natural surface. Pre-finish options are available.
<b>Source:</b>	Historic Structures of Pennsylvania	<b>Moisture Content:</b>	Kiln dried 6–9% prior to shipment/milling.
<b>Color:</b>	Tones may range from tan to smokey amber to rich coffee brown. Reclaimed products may exhibit an indefinite range of color variations.	<b>Knots:</b>	There are no restrictions on the presence of sound knots.
<b>Original Edge Dimensions:</b>	N/A	<b>Texture:</b>	Various saw blade textures, animal wear, beetle tracking, hardware & fastener impressions.
<b>Common Dimensions:</b>	Height   5/8" & 3/4" Width   3,4,5,6"   4,5,6,7"   5,6,7,8"   7,8,9,10" Length   2-12'	<b>Voids:</b>	Chips & open knots with a diameter of up to 1" may be present. In some cases, larger voids may be included to maintain the board's length.
<b>Rare/Custom Dimensions:</b>	Height   N/A Width   Singular   5, 7, 9" Length   Singular or 12'	<b>Discoloration:</b>	There is no limit to the amount of natural weather & mineral staining.
		<b>Checks:</b>	Structural checks that do not compromise the plank's integrity after installation are permissible and tend to be more common as the material's width increases.

### TIPS FROM THE MILL

- If you are installing material 7" or wider, we suggest a nail and glue down. Bostik's BEST makes a great adhesive with a moisture vapor barrier.
- When including a pre-finish to any flooring, a micro bevel is required to keep the finish from standing proud on the edges.
- Ask us about matching stair parts, registers, & transitions. We offer all standard nosing, returns, risers, stringers, & landing treads.

### NEED A QUOTE? WE'LL NEED SOME DETAILS.

- How much square footage do you need for this project?
  - We suggest 10-15% overage for waste & fall off.
- What widths & lengths do you need? Wider or singular widths and longer lengths possess a higher level of rarity & increased investment.
- What thickness would you like?
  - 5/8" allows the mill to choose from a larger range of material, in certain instances, decreasing lead time.
- Would you like a milled profile or straight edge?
  - Straight Edge (SLR)
  - Tongue & Groove (T&G)
  - End-Matched (EM) \*10" Max
  - Micro Bevel (MB)
  - Eased Edge (EE)
- How are you planning on shipping the material? Whether its LTL, Hot-shot or Full Truckload, we can assist with set-up.

Tip - You can create an original edge look by easing/texturizing the edges & naturally or lightly staining them.
